Student Bus Pass

All students enrolled in Salem-Keizer public middle and high schools are eligible to ride Cherriots free during the 10-11 school year.

Our goal is to reduce traffic around local schools by encouraging more students to ride a bus for their school commute, as well as riding to other destinations. This will improve student safety, decrease fuel consumption, enhance air quality, and improve the quality of life in our community. This does NOT replace yellow bus service, but expands students' travel options.

To ride Cherriots for free, a student will need to have a valid Cherriots identification on their 2010-2011 school photo identification card. With a valid Cherriots sticker or imprint on their ID card students may ride free any time, anywhere Cherriots serves, through the end of the school year.

- ***Do not eat on a Cherriots bus - drinks in a sealed container are OK.***
- ***Keep your music to yourself - ear buds or headphones are OK if no one else can hear your music.***
- ***Offer your seat to an elderly or disabled person.***
- ***Keep your feet off the seats.***
- ***Talk softly and do not use offensive language.***

Riding Cherriots is a privilege, not a right. Your student's bus pass may be revoked at any time for misconduct.
