Salem-Keizer Transit Title VI Statement

Making a Title VI complaint

Any person who believes he or she has been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with Salem-Keizer Transit. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with Salem-Keizer Transit within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
